Who are the personnel on a drilling rig called?

The majority of the personnel on the drilling rig, called 'the rig crew', are employees of the drilling contractor. The company man is the on-site manager and lead representative of the operating/exploration company and is "in charge" of the drilling and all associated activities.

What does an oil and gas drilling company man do?

Overall, the duties of an Oil and Gas Drilling Company Man encompass a range of responsibilities related to operational oversight, contractor management, health and safety, decision-making, quality assurance, reporting, and coordination.

Who owns a drilling rig?

Most gas and oil-drilling exploration companies rent or lease the drilling rig from a drilling company who owns the rig, the drilling contractor. The majority of the personnel on the drilling rig, called 'the rig crew', are employees of the drilling contractor.

How to start a career in oil rigging and drilling?

To begin a career in offshore oil rigging and drilling, if you have no experience in the industry or have never worked at sea or on a land oil drilling platform, it's recommended to start from an entry-level position. A good way to prepare is by working for 1 to 2 years in each of the oilfield industries mentioned above.

How do I become a rig manager?

Level of Education: Gaining advanced degrees may allow this role to increase their income potential and qualify for promotions. **Managing Experience:** If you are a Rig Manager that oversees more junior Rig Managers, this experience can increase the likelihood to earn more.

Who is a rigsite manager?

This person may also be called the company representative, rigsite foreman, drill site supervisor (DSV), company consultant, rigsite leader or "well site manager". Most gas and oil-drilling exploration companies rent or lease the drilling rig from a drilling company who owns the rig, the drilling contractor.
