How are Britannia's reserves developed?

Britannia's reserves are being developed through a single drilling,production and accommodation platform. The Britannia field,discovered in the mid 1970s,is the first in the UK sector of the North Sea to be operated jointly by two companies,Conoco and Chevron,through the formation of the new operating company,Britannia Operator Limited.

Britannia,situated 210km (130 miles) north-east of Aberdeen,covers approximately 112km²; (70m²).

Where is Britannia gas transported?

Britannia gas is transported through a dedicated Britannia Gas Pipeline to the Scottish Area Gas Evacuation facility at St. Fergus,Scotland. The Brodgar,Callanish,Enochdhu and Finlaggan fields have been developed as satellites of the Britannia field. The Ithaca Energy operated Alder development is also a satellite of the Britannia field.

Where is the Britannia Field?

The Britannia field lies approximately 130 miles (210km) northeast of Aberdeen,Scotland,in the UK Central North Sea,in water depths of approximately 480 feet (146m).
