What is a cable tool rig?

Cable tool rigs were the first drilling rigs used for hydrocarbon wells. They were used in the United States in the second half of the nineteenth century (1800s) to drill shallow hydrocarbon wells in the Appalachian Region. While these rigs are no longer used in modern oil and gas well drilling, they are of historical note.

Where did cable tool rigs come from?

Cable tool rigs were originally used in the United States for drilling water wells in the early 1800s but had their origins in the percussive drilling techniques used by ancient Chinese and Persian civilizations. They were adapted in the mid- to late-1800s for drilling hydrocarbon wells.

What is cable tool drilling?

Cable tool drilling, also known as percussion drilling, is a method that uses a heavy drill bit suspended by a cable. The drill bit is raised and then dropped into the borehole to break up rock and soil. The broken material is removed using a bailer or sand pump. How deep is a cable-tool rig?

The record depth recorded for a cable-tool rig is 11,145 feet. On Russia's Kola Peninsula, a rotary rig reached more than 40,000 feet after ten years of drilling. Today, the latest technologies are used for rotary drilling and production.
