How many rigs are there in Alberta?

This analysis focuses on three key areas: rig count by province, activity by field centre, and the top 10 accounts by record count. A province-level comparison reveals a slight decline in overall rig activity. Alberta, the most active region, saw a small decrease in rigs from 195 to 193 (-1.03%).

What is rig utilization in Canada?

And after the well is complete, other oilfield services work to bring the well into production and to maintain it. Rig utilization is a large percentage of active rigs.
