How many rigs drilling for oil in Canada?

More recently, on 10 July 2020 there were 6 rigs drilling for oil in Canada. In June the number of rigs drilling for either oil or gas averaged 18 per day, the lowest number since at least 1964, when data for all Canadian drilling was first recorded. Global investment in oil and gas has decreased significantly because of much lower oil prices.

What is Canada oil rig count?

Canada Oil Rig Count is at a current level of 120.00, down from 123.00 last week and down from 153.00 one year ago. This is a change of -2.44% from last week and -21.57% from one year ago. Are rigs drilling for oil a seasonal trend in Canada?

Rigs drilling for oil display a seasonal pattern in Canada. In 2019, rigs drilling for oil increased from 17 at the beginning of May to 84 by the last week of June. Over the same time period in 2020, rigs drilling for oil in Canada decreased from 7 to 4. Canadian oil rig activity differs from the U.S. because Canadian drilling is largely seasonal.

How many rigs are there in Canada this year?

However, this year Canada's rig count fell by 98% from its height of 172 to only 4 active rigs and has not begun its usual summer increase. AER, Breaking up ain't hard to do - The Spring thaw puts a freeze on much of Alberta's drilling activity.

What is rig utilization in Canada?

And after the well is complete, other oilfield services work to bring the well into production and to maintain it. Rig utilization is a large percentage of active rigs.
