What is Canada oil rig count?

Canada Oil Rig Count is at a current level of 120.00, down from 123.00 last week and down from 153.00 one year ago. This is a change of -2.44% from last week and -21.57% from one year ago. Alberta rig activity increased to 135 active rigs from 110 last week. Saskatchewan's rig count decreased from 31 to 27, while BC's active rig count remained at 21. The rig count increase was driven predominantly by oil targeted drilling as the number of oil rigs increased from 108 to 122 over the last week.

What is rig utilization in Canada?
