Could the worst offshore oil rig disasters have been avoided?

Rig explosions, fires, capsizing/sinking, oil spills, and the loss of workers and marine lives have been the most catastrophic forms of offshore oil and gas drilling disasters in recorded history. Investigational reports on some of the world's worst offshore oil rig disasters suggest that most of these accidents could have been avoided.

How many people died in a rig accident?

Tragically, this accident led to the death of 72 of 76 workers onboard. While the rig was being towed between China and Korea, a storm with force 10 winds caused waves to crash over the main deck. These waves inflicted significant damage to the deck, causing flooding of the rig. This, alongside the relentless storm, capsized the rig.

What rig disasters were caused by natural forces?

The other major drilling rig disasters caused by natural forces include the Bohai 2 oil rig disaster (November 1979) offshore China that took 72 lives. The incident occurred when the jack-up rig capsized and sank after the fierce winds broke the ventilator pump and caused a puncture hole in the deck, resulting in extensive flooding.
