How much does a drill rig operator make?

The average Drill Rig Operator salary in the United States is \$43,509 as of March 28, 2023, but the salary range typically falls between \$42,309 and \$47,782. Salary ranges can vary widely depending on many important factors, including education, certifications, additional skills, the number of years you have spent in your profession.

How much does a rig engineer make?

The estimated total pay for a Rig Engineer is \$127,416 per year in the United States area, with an average salary of \$95,802 per year. These numbers represent the median, which is the midpoint of the ranges from our proprietary Total Pay Estimate model and based on salaries collected from our users. The estimated additional pay is \$31,614 per year.

How much do oil rig operators make a year?

Radio operators are in charge of oil rig communications, and they make an average of \$40,300 per year. Medics are on board in the case of any injuries or illnesses, and they earn \$44,850 per year. Oil rig cooks make an average of \$38,350 per year, according to Rigworker.

How much do oil rig mechanics make?

Chief mechanics make \$52,000 per year, regular mechanics can earn \$46,800 per year and assistant mechanics make \$42,250 per year. There are many other types of positions needed to run an oil rig as well. Radio operators are in charge of oil rig communications, and they make an average of \$40,300 per year.

How much does a drilling rig cost per day?

Your daily rate depends on the rig type, distance from shore, drilling depth, and water depth. Onshore drilling rates range from \$200,000 to \$310,000 each day. Offshore drilling can cost between \$600,000 to \$800,000 per day.

Are oil rig workers getting paid more?

Over the past five years, oil rig worker salaries have shown steady improvement following the industry's slump in 2021 and 2022. The year 2024 marked a shift, with more oil field workers seeing salary increases than pay freezes. Today, 50% of professionals report earning more than the year before, and 26% received pay rises above five per cent.
