



# Drilling rig wages 2019

How much do oil rig workers make?

A typical wage for an oil rig worker varies greatly depending on the specific job they are doing and the experience they possess. For example, a Roughneck, or entry-level rig worker, can typically earn between \$15 to \$25 an hour performing day-to-day tasks such as cleaning equipment and helping assemble drilling tools.

How much overtime do oil rig operators get paid?

The answer will vary from job to job based upon location and employer stipulations; however, generally speaking oil rig operators can expect overtime wages paid at 1.5x regular hourly rate if they exceed 40 hour mark per week according to federal labor standards set forth in US (and likely other producing countries).

How much does a Rotary Driller make?

Rotary drillers average \$27.44 per hour or \$57,070 per year according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. They handle the drills that either produce oil from underground or remove core samples for testing, keep drilling records, and maintain the drill rigs. They also retrieve broken drill bits and other equipment from wells.

Are offshore oil rig workers a good job?

Offshore oil rigs provide an important source of revenue to many countries, and offshore oil workers often enjoy lucrative career options. Oil rig workers in the U.S. are well-paid compared to most other occupations, and the earning potential can increase quickly due to good working conditions and high demand for skilled personnel.

How much does a drilling engineer make a year?

This can increase to anywhere between \$60k-80k for workers with more experience and higher levels of responsibility. Salaries will also increase to around \$90-150k range for those that hold executive roles or technical positions such as offshore drilling managers or drilling engineers.
