



Drilling rig wages in Canada

How much do you get paid on a drilling rig?

Caodc updated its recommended wage schedule for drilling rigs on November 1st. The wages are only accessible to Caodc members right now but from memory: Driller: \$42 Derrickhand: \$36 Motorhand: \$31 Roughneck: \$29 Leasehand: \$28 Rig technician premiums are still in place. ~5% cut for everyone. Wages had been cut in the previous update (July).

How many rigs drilling for oil in Canada?

More recently, on 10 July 2020 there were 6 rigs drilling for oil in Canada. In June the number of rigs drilling for either oil or gas averaged 18 per day, the lowest number since at least 1964, when data for all Canadian drilling was first recorded. Global investment in oil and gas has decreased significantly because of much lower oil prices.

Are rigs drilling for oil a seasonal trend in Canada?

Rigs drilling for oil display a seasonal pattern in Canada. In 2019, rigs drilling for oil increased from 17 at the beginning of May to 84 by the last week of June. Over the same time period in 2020, rigs drilling for oil in Canada decreased from 7 to 4. Canadian oil rig activity differs from the U.S. because Canadian drilling is largely seasonal.

Who is the largest drilling rig contractor in Canada?

Precision Drilling Corporation is the largest drilling rig contractor in Canada, also providing oil field rental and supplies. Precision Drilling Ltd. was founded in 1951. In 1987, Precision Drilling was acquired by Cypress Drilling, led by president Hank Swartout, in a reverse takeover which left the company with a fleet of 19 rigs.
