How to remove a cordless drill chuck?

What size Chuck do you need for a cordless drill?

Most cordless drills have either a 3/8-inch or 1/2-inch chuck. Consequently, you will need a chuck key that matches the chuck size of your drill. Check the chuck for any engraved size measurements or consult the drill's user manual for the correct size of chuck key.

How do you secure a drill chuck?

To secure the chuck, it is essential to lock the drill's spindle in place. This can be achieved by placing a hex key or an adjustable wrench into the chuck and turning it clockwise. This action will tighten the jaws of the chuck, preventing the spindle from rotating while removing the chuck.
