How many rigs did Halliburton sell in Q4 2021?

The total number of rigs increased from 1,332 in Q4 2020 to 1,352 in Q4 2021, making a slight increment of 1.5% on a year-on-year basis. However, it decreased by 4.72% on a quarterly basis, from 1,419 in Q3 2021 to 1,352 in Q4 2021. Halliburton generates a major part of its revenue from the selling of rigs in the International regions.
