How many oil rigs are in the Gulf of Mexico?

In the Gulf of Mexico, oil rigs go beyond the edge of the continental shelf, 100 miles offshore, to around 350 miles from the Gulf shores. Let's explore the 10 Major Oil Rigs in the Gulf of Mexico. Petronius is one of the biggest oil platforms in the Gulf of Mexico, operated by Chevron, 210 km southeast of New Orleans, US.

How many abandoned oil rigs are in the Gulf of Mexico?

The Gulf of Mexico is home to over 4,000 abandoned oil rigs. The majority of these oil rigs were abandoned between the late 1970s and early 1990s when oil prices plummeted below \$10 per barrel and the offshore drilling industry went into decline. Many of these rigs were simply abandoned, leaving them to rust and fall apart.

When did oil rigs start in the Gulf of Mexico?

Oil platforms in the Gulf of Mexico began appearing in the 1940s and became more elaborate, complex, advanced and multi-purpose structures with the passage of time. The initial oil rigs were small and were used to extract oil from the nearshore wells. In the 1970s, bigger platforms were being constructed in deeper waters.

How much oil is in the Gulf of Mexico?

The Gulf of Mexico reserves are estimated to contain 3.44 billion barrels of oil and 5.7 trillion cubic feet of natural gas that can be procured from the 459 active oil and gas fields in the region. The Gulf of Mexico offshore oil production is 15% of the total crude oil production of the United States.

How far away are oil rigs in the Gulf?

Smaller rigs and platforms may be located just a few meters from the shore. Others are behemoth facilities operating in water up to 10,000 feet deep and 250 miles from the shore. For a frame of reference, some of the most notable Gulf rigs include: How far out are oil rigs in the Gulf?
