How much does a rock excavator cost?

Rock excavation costs \$50 to \$200 per cubic yard to remove large boulders if storing them somewhere else on-site or \$220 to \$250 per cubic yard if hauling them offsite. Excavation costs can jump to \$15,000 to \$20,000+ if the excavator hits rock when digging a foundation, basement, or pool.

How much does a pool excavation cost?

Swimming pool excavation costs \$1,500 to \$5,000 on average if the soil is soft and free of obstructions. Excavation costs can increase to \$15,000 to \$20,000 for a difficult-to-access area, challenging terrain with boulders or hardpan, or a rock ledge that requires jackhammering or blasting. Installing an inground pool costs \$25,000 to \$100,000.

In addition to the investment in hard rock directional drilling equipment and accessories, rock drilling is, by nature, slower going than dirt drilling: it's a double whammy. Plus, you'll incur added personnel costs since the jobs take longer.

How much does it cost to dig a rock ledge?

Excavation costs \$2.50 to \$15.00 per cubic yard, depending on the soil type, depth, terrain, and number of obstructions. Sand or light soil costs the least to dig, while excavating rocky soil or a rock ledge that requires jackhammering costs \$50 to \$200+ per cubic yard. *Including labor and equipment.
