



How to install the winch of a down-the-hole drill

How to install a winch?

Trace the holes inside the marking plate as well as its outline. Now, you have to drill these holes in addition to an extra hole for the wires. After this, you mount the winch and then secure it using bolts. Finally, you will finish the installation by wiring the winch. Follow the steps below in order to complete this procedure with ease.

How do you drill holes for a winch cable?

To drill holes for a winch cable, first use a pen to trace the shape of the cable on the trailer. Make a note of where the holes on the winch correspond to these marks. Time for Drilling! Make a series of holes where you marked some minutes earlier with a strong drill. Once the holes match up, set the winch cable straight.

How to install a winch on an angle iron?

Now you have to drill the winch mounting plate onto the angle iron's center. This will improve the strength as well as the symmetry of the unit. After this you have to mount the winch onto the winch mount and secure it tightly using bolts. Lastly, make sure you wire the winch onto the car battery.

How to install a winch on a goose neck trailer?

Put the mounting plate of the winch against the goose neck trailer and mark its outline as well as its holes. Next, you have to drill the holes that you have marked on the trailer. The correct placement and drilling of these holes are extremely important. Put the winch mount in position and secure it in place using bolts.

How to install a winch on a truck bed?

Begin by measuring the length of the truck's bed. Next you have to weld the angle iron onto your bed. You can do this by first welding all the iron onto the metal brackets. After this you have to bolt all these brackets into place. Before you do this, make sure you know how far from the bed's end you want the winch to sit.
