Why does California still have offshore oil wells?

The recent oil spill in Southern California has many residents questioning why the state still has offshore oil wells. Despite California declaring an end to new drilling over 50 years ago and the federal government stopping new leases over 35 years ago, offshore oil wells still exist.

How much oil does Huntington Beach produce?

As of 2000, Huntington Beach had produced over a billion barrels of oil and 845 billion cf of natural gas. In 2013, the USGS estimated that the Huntington Beach Oil Field could produce an additional 117 to 866 million barrels of oil, with their best estimate being 370 million barrels.

In fact, eight oil and gas platforms off California already have terminated leases and no longer produce oil and gas. The other fifteen platforms are still operational but production ...
