Successful expansions into the shallower Mayes and Caney shales drove the Arkoma Basin rig count to an all-time high of 50 in 2008. Unfortunately, success would be short-lived. A couple of years later, gas prices would crash, and activity diminishes almost to a standstill. The Basin's largest operators sold off their assets and exited the Play.

Is Arkoma a dry gas shale?

It's primarily a dry gas play but features an oil and condensate window on its western extent. Arkoma's Woodford shale extends further into the Southern Oklahoma Basin and western Oklahoma's Anadarko Basin. Oil and gas production in the Arkoma region began in the 1930's with the drilling of conventional vertical wells.

Where is the Arkoma Basin?

His company operates just to the west of the original Arkoma Basin boundary in Hughes County, Oklahoma, drilling targets in rock it says is geologically equivalent to that found in the STACK and SCOOP. For example, he claims the shallower, more permeable Mayes formation, overlying the Woodford, is like that found in the STACK Meramec.
