How many diamond rigs are there?

The combined company will operate a total of 41 rigs, 28 floaters, and 13 jackups. Of that fleet, ten are Diamond rigs, all floaters: four being seventh generation drillships, three of which are working in the US Gulf of Mexico. There are also two DP semisubs, and three moored semisubs, one of which, Ocean Onyx, is stacked in Malaysia.

What happened to diamond rigs?

In January 2014, Diamond had 30 floating rigs in service, but with an average age of over thirty years. The company also owned seven jackups, but six of the seven were also over thirty years of age. Thus, when the downturn came, Diamond's vintage fleet was amongst the first to be idled by clients as old and inefficient, and then scrapped.

Who built the first oil rig?

Alexander Shipyard in New Orleans constructed the company's first rig, which was delivered in 1954 and immediately contracted to Shell Oil. The rig was named Mr. Charlie after Charles Murphy. Mr. Charlie was retired in 1986.

Who owns 32 percent of Seadrill?

Aquadrill's unitholders ended up owning 32 per cent of Seadrill after the deal. Unfortunately, before we get too cocky, we should recall that we had predicted only three weeks before the Noble deal was announced that we expected the buyer of Diamond would be Seadrill.

What happened to Aquadrill?

Aquadrill had already fallen to Seadrill a few months later, in December 2022, in an all-stock deal that valued Aquadrill's equity at approximately US\$958 million. Aquadrill's unitholders ended up owning 32 per cent of Seadrill after the deal.
