



## Patterson drilling rig explosion

How many workers have died at Patterson-UTI well sites?

OKLAHOMA CITY (AP) -- Ten workers have died over the past decade at well sites linked to drilling contractor Patterson-UTI, the same driller involved in this week's rig explosion in Oklahoma that killed five workers, federal records show.

What topics are discussed at Patterson Drilling?

At Patterson Drilling, topics of discussion include skills and training, pay raises and promotions, management and culture, company values, community, the relevance of the mission, and moving on. Additionally, there is exploration of PTO allowances, work-life balance and flexibility, and parental leave.

How many Patterson-UTI employees died in Texas rig accidents?

The report devoted an entire section to the company and 13 employees who died in Texas rig accidents over a nearly four-year period. A separate AP analysis published in 2008 showed at least 20 Patterson-UTI employees died on the job between 2002 and 2007. No other oil and gas company had more than five fatal accidents during that span.

Is this the deadliest oil rig accident ever?

Monday's explosion and rig fire appear to be the deadliest oil and gas industry accident since 2010, when 11 workers were killed after an explosion on BP's Deepwater Horizon rig in the Gulf of Mexico that triggered the biggest offshore oil spill in U.S. history.

Did Patterson-UTI drill a new well?

Another well had recently been drilled by Patterson-UTI on this pad without incident. Drilling of 1H-9 began on January 11, 2018, and currently the CSB is unaware of any deviations from the original well plan.

Why did RMO pull the drillpipe out of the well?

At the time of the incident, the rig crew had recently pulled the drillpipe and associated drilling tools out of the well in preparation to change out the drill bit. Both RMO and Patterson-UTI have cooperated with the CSB's investigation and promptly provided the well plan, daily drilling reports, and electronic rig data.
