



## Semi-submersible drilling rig day rate

Why is global demand for semi-submersible rigs rising?

Global demand for semi-submersible rigs and drillships has surged, with day rates at their highest point in almost a decade due to a booming drilling market and a limited supply of rigs, according to a new report.

How much does a semi-sub rig cost?

As a result of the boost in the semi-sub market, day rates for recent contract fixtures have also risen, with some well above \$400,000, which has not been witnessed since 2015. Currently, the semi-sub fleet is made up of 27 active rigs, which are either on hire or have a contract starting in the future.

Is 2024 a good year for the offshore drilling rig market?

How much do ultra-deepwater rigs cost a day?

Benign ultra-deepwater rigs have maintained an average daily rate of \$420,000 in the first half of 2023, with utilization rates reaching an impressive 90%. "With increasing demand and rates, we are approaching the tipping point for new builds and reactivations," said Cook.
