How did old timers drill wells?

Drilling Equipment - The old timers used cable tools to drill wells, which meant repeatedly dropping a heavy drill bit on the end of a hemp rope - the cable - down a well hole to slowly deepen it.

What is the difference between 2019 and old well rigs?

The difference between 2019 and those old rigs is about the difference between the space shuttle and the Wright brothers' first airplane. As an older man and longtime member of the industry, when I'm gone -- and my colleagues are too -- there won't be any first-hand recollections of using these crude, old well rigs.

Do cows need a well Rig?

Most of the farmers milked cows and I understand a good milk cow will drink about 35 gallons of water a day, so a good supply was really a necessity if the farmer had any kind of a herd. So my father informed his boss that they needed a well rig. They found one about 50 miles away and bought it.

What happens if there is no water in a drilling hole?

Water from the surrounding rock formations typically flows into the hole during drilling, but if no water is present, then it needs to be added so that the pulverized drilling debris, which are known as cuttings, can be converted into a thick, muddy mess.

Who built the Hyatt well drill rig?

A steam powered core drill rig from the 1890s sent in by Jeff Hyatt of Hyatt Well Drilling in New York. Jeff Hyatt, shown with daughter Cassandra, rebuilt this rig from the ground up. His father, who was also a well driller, knew the owner. A close up of the restored rig, which is fully functional.

Are there any old Keystone rigs in the oilfields?

A considerable number of portable rig models were put out by that company. Old abandoned Keystone drillers have been seen by the author in the oilfields. This cut is from an ad in the April 1902 issue of the Petroleum Gazette. This Keystone model was a favored oil drilling machine of that time.
