



# Sweden Recycling Second-hand Rock Drills

How many tons of mining waste are there in Sweden?

The Geological Survey of Sweden (SGU) is now publishing the first of a total of six reports with results from sampling of waste from closed Swedish mines. In Sweden, there are over one hundred million tons of historical mining waste in the form of waste rock and tailings that can potentially contain valuable materials.

What is a circular economy in Swedish Recycling?

One way forward in Swedish recycling is to increase reuse and repairs of consumer products. And over the years, the movement of sharing and reusing all kinds of things, clothes and furniture, has grown enormously. Circular economy is an approach that involves using products that can be reused completely, a so-called cradle-to-cradle approach.

How are recyclable materials processed in Sweden?

In Sweden, recyclables are methodically separated into well-defined categories. Each category ensures that materials are processed in the most environmentally friendly and efficient manner possible: Glass: Broken down into colored and clear. These are melted down and remolded into new glass products.

How do you dispose of hazardous waste in Sweden?

For their proper disposal, Sweden has designated collection points and specialized hazardous waste facilities. To ensure the safety of both the environment and residents, one can find detailed guidelines and collection points on the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency's website. Adjusting to a new country's recycling protocols can be daunting.
