Why does my air compressor smell like burning?

It can come into contact with the engine when it gets to this state and burns. A more common problem with the air compressor is when the clutch becomes stuck and won't allow the belt to turn. This can cause friction and give off a burning smell too.

Why does my air compressor smell like rubber?

The air valve holds the air in the tank. If the air valve in your compressor unit is faulty, the air will escape from the tank. This puts a strain on the air compressor engine and can cause smoking. The smell of burning rubber is mostly due to an oil leak.

Why does my rotary screw air compressor make a strange noise?

An unusual noise in a rotary screw air compressor is most likely due to worn airend bearings. Pay close attention to oil leaks and strange noises from the motor bearings as these are the two main indicators of potential issues with the air compressor.

How does a screw compressor work?

A screw compressor can run loaded ('pumping air') or unloaded ('idle'). The inlet/loading valve opens and closes according to air demand. The inlet valve is controlled by a solenoid valve that supplies control air to the inlet/loading valve. Check solenoid valve coil and solenoid valve operation.

Why is my air compressor smoking?

There are various reasons for the smoking of an air compressor, and it could happen without warning. When this happens, it may sometimes have a burning rubber odor. The air compressor is designed so that oil circulates properly, lubricating the air pump and engine. There is usually a recommended oil level, and when this drops, smoking occurs.

How do I know if my compressor is bad?

Check the isolation of the motor windings. Should be in the mega-ohms (you need an isolation tester / high voltage ohm meter for this). Check the voltage when the compressor is running. If the voltage drop significantly when the compressor starts/runs, you have a bad connection somewhere. Check all relays, fuses and electrical connections.
