With its adjustable jaws, a drill's chuck allows you to change between bits of different shapes and sizes, such as round or hexagonal shank. The shank is the smooth part of the bit inserted into the chuck. It also allows you to switch between different types of bits, such as screwdriver bits and drill bits.

Here's how to change the bit on a drill with a keyless chuck. **STEP 1:** Switch the drill into the counter-clockwise position. Take the drill in both hands, with one hand on the grip and the other on the drill chuck.

Apply a screwdriver: To change the bit of a drill that doesn't include a self-locking function; you can use a screwdriver to adjust the fastener that holds the drill bit.
