What does an oil rig motorhand do?

As the job title implies, the primary responsibilities of the oil rig motorhand (or motorman) are to keep the engines that power the drilling equipment and some of the other rig equipment working smoothly.

What does a motorman do on an oil rig?

The main job of a motorman is to keep all rig equipment, especially the engine of the drill equipment, running smoothly. A motorman spends majority of his time on equipment maintenance but his other duties include ordering tools and replacement parts for the engine, training the floorhands, and assisting the other oil rig crew members when needed.

What is the difference between rig crew and motorman?

1. n. [Drilling] The member of the rig crew responsible for maintenance of the engines. While all members of the rig crew help with major repairs, the motorman does routine preventive maintenance and minor repairs. See related terms: drilling crew

What does a rig maintenance supervisor do?

Work closely with the oil rig crew and assist other members of the crew as instructed by the Rig Maintenance Supervisor. The Motorman operates and maintains drilling mud systems and pumps during drilling. When a minor fault is detected with equipment, the Motorman finds a way to salvage the state of such equipment.

What does a motorman do?

A motorman carries out a myriad of obligations to ensure the upkeep and functionality of all the systems involved in an operation. Other responsibilities include the following: Regular inspection of machinery, as well as the bilge, pump rooms, and tanks. Ensure the engine room is neatly kept and all equipment is properly stowed.

How do I become an oil rig motorhand?

Train new crew members to do the same. The following job titles also refer to oil rig motorhand: High school diploma is generally required to work as oil rig motorhand. However, this requirement may differ in some countries. ISCO skill level is defined as a function of the complexity and range of tasks and duties to be performed in an occupation.
