How much does it cost to drill a horizontal well?

Cost depend on the depth and complexity of the well. Modern horizontal well drilling costs can easily exceed \$4,000,000 just in the drilling phase. Without drilling complications these wells generally take about 3 weeks for the drilling phase. Moving a drilling rig is not a simple task.

How much does well drilling cost?

Well drilling prices range from \$30 to \$80+ per foot for a complete installation or \$20 to \$30 per foot just to drill. Expect to pay significantly more when digging in remote areas or through rocky, sloped, dry, or low-quality soil. The table below shows the average well drilling and well system installation costs for various depths.

How much does a drilling rig cost?

Looking at the total cost of a drilling operation means more than just the rig's price. Fuel costs for big rigs can add up quickly, as they run non-stop. For example, drilling a horizontal well can cost over \$4 million and take about three weeks. Another big expense is labor. The job needs skilled people, with 40-50 companies often involved.

How much does it cost to rig a well?

The process normally takes 3-5 days. After the well is drilled the rig must be cleaned and disassembled and moved off location. Rig mobilization and assembly expenses vary depending on how far the rig must be transported, but generally run between \$100,000 to \$350,000..

Should you buy a used drilling rig?

The used drilling rig market is a cost-effective option for operators. Prices change based on age, condition, and demand. On average, machines stay listed for 180 days on used equipment websites. When looking at a used rig, buyers need to think about maintenance costs. These costs can be quite high.
