How much fuel does a drill use?

If there is, then it will destroy a chunk of terrain approximately 2m wide by 2.2m tall by 1m deep in the direction that the player is looking. While in Mining Mode, the drills will not deal damage, even if there are valid targets in range. In Combat mode, the Drills will consume 0.2 liters of Fuel per tick, with a 8 ticks per second rate.

What happens if a drill runs out of fuel?

The Drills become inoperable if they run out of fuel. In Mining mode, regardless of successfully breaking terrain or not, the Drills will consume 0.25 liters of Fuel per tick. By default they have a 1.5 tick per second rate, but with mods it can be raised up to 3 ticks per second.

Can the drills mine minerals?

However, the Drills are unable to mine minerals. The Drills gain 1 Heat per second while the [FIRE] key ("Left Mouse Click" by default) is held down and lose 2 Heat per second while idle. At the Max Heat of 5.5 they will overheat and become inoperable for 8s while they slowly return to 0 Heat.

How do you refuel a Drilldozer with oil shale?

Oil Shale is a resource used to refuel the Drilldozer in Escort Duty . Oil Shale can be mined with the Drilldozer's Fuel Canisters or broken into chunks with the Pickaxe or Bosco. It can be collected only with Fuel Canisters, converting the shale into fuel. It cannot be picked up by dwarves, and therefore cannot be deposited in the M.U.L.E. .

Do drills become more fuel efficient?
