Purchased in 2010, three Dando Watertec 24 drilling rigs are supplying water to UNAMID's military bases in Darfur. With a pullback capacity of 24,000kgf the Watertec 24 is designed for working in harsh conditions and it is capable of mud rotary, air and flooded reverse drilling.
