A drilling rig is an apparatus constructed for oil drilling. The term "rig" generally refers to the equipment used to penetrate the Earth's crust. Oil and natural gas drilling rigs are used to identify geologic reservoirs and create holes to extract oil or natural gas from those reservoirs.

How many rigs are there in the US?

Baker Hughes reports 554 active drilling rigs in the US. In April, the total active rig count was 587. One year ago, the total active rig count was 588. The oil rig count is currently 438 rigs, compared to 483 in April and 485 one year ago. The gas rig count is 111, compared to 99 in April and 98 last June.

How do oil and natural gas drilling rigs work?

Oil and natural gas drilling rigs are used to identify geologic reservoirs and create holes to extract oil or natural gas from those reservoirs. Onshore oil and gas fields typically have a larger rig that drills a well, which is then replaced with a smaller service rig that gets the well online.
